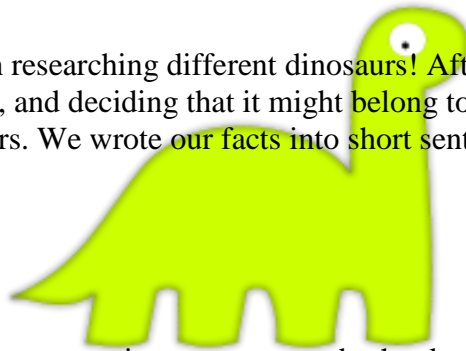
Art Evening
