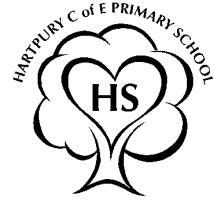

Well done to our year 3/4 cricket team who took part in the primary quest tournament at Redmarley Cricket Club yesterday afternoon.

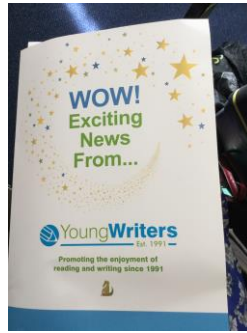


## Class 1 – Trip to Puzzlewood
